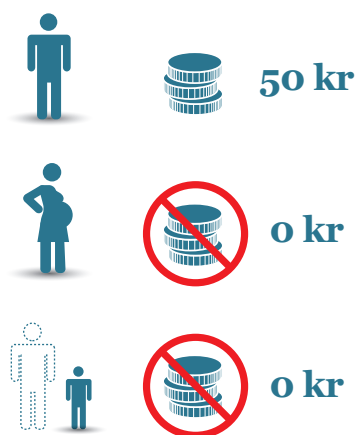

1. Book an appointment with your local healthcare centre
2. Arrive on time
3. Remember to bring your LMA-card
4. An interpreter will be available in person or over the telephone. All interpreters are bound by confidentiality.

5. Asylum seeking adults (aged 18 and over) are entitled to the following healthcare services:



All emergency healthcare (as assessed by medical staff)



Confidentiality applies at all times



Children

6. Rights of children and young people (aged 0 - 17)



Asylum seeking children and youth (under the age of 18) are entitled to the same health and medical care (including dental care) as all other children and youth in Sweden



Children and youth (under the age of 18) do not have to pay for their healthcare
